

Technical and Security, Stability & Resiliency

Key Accomplishments since ICANN 52

- Delivered 29 identifier security / operations trainings across all of ICANN's regions. Launched a "train the trainer" course on DNS operations with partner Network Startup Resource Center
- Public consultation on draft plan for rolling the Root Zone DNSSEC Key Signing Key to be initiated immediately after ICANN 53

- Executed plan to upgrade cryptographic hardware for signing root zone
- Publication of a booklet describing the IANA functions.

- Email address internationalization identified as biggest challenge to achieving success.



- Six scripts added in recent update of Maximal Starting Repertoire (Armenian, Ethiopic, Khmer, Myanmar, Thaana, Tibetan)




New gTLD Program: Driving Toward Completion

New gTLD Program Auction Proceeds

Contention Resolution Statistics

- 88% complete 204 of 233 contention sets resolved
- 40 sets resolved since ICANN 52
- 29 sets remain to be resolved
- 13 sets resolved via ICANN Auction;3 resolved since ICANN 52

Net proceeds to date: US\$ 58.8M

- Funds segregated. Community discussing use in Buenos Aires.

Why Auctions?

Only one registry can operate a top-level domain. Auction is the "mechanism of last resort" for resolving contention for the same string.
