### Key Elements of Proposal

**Proposed Schedule** 

Three AoC Reviews and initial work on the At-Large Review are proposed for FY2016, and three Organizational Reviews would be deferred until FY2017.



Focus on Operational Effectiveness

Include self-assessments and focused preparatory actions by the organization under review.

Clear and focused Review scope, consistent budgeting, and cost tracking.

Alternative Process for Examination of Strategic Issues


Consider establishing an alternate process (to Organizational Reviews) to examine strategic issues such as the continued purpose of organizations.

**Streamline AoC Review Teams and Review Duration** 

Ensure that volunteers' skills and expertise are well aligned with the requirements for a given Review and modify terms of service to align with implementation planning.

### Process Improvements

#### Underway

- ✓ Global standards of the Project Management Institute used in implementing improvements arising out of Reviews (piloted for ATRT2 implementation).
- Improved tracking, reporting and oversight of implementation progress (including centralized tracking and revamped icann.org webpage).
- ✓ Improved planning and resource/budget allocation prior to the start of the Reviews.


### Considered by the Board



### ATRT2 Review Implementation Status\*





### The Affirmation of Commitments

**Scope:** Review examines the extent to which new gTLDs have promoted competition, consumer trust and consumer choice,

as well as effectiveness of

- (a) the application and evaluation process, and
- (b) safeguards put in place to mitigate issues involved in the introduction or expansion

**Recurring Reviews:** 1 yr after New gTLDs in operation, 2 years later, and then at least every 4 yrs

**Outcome:** Recs sent to Board, which acts within 6 mo. Implementation or if necessary, GNSO PDP follows Board action



### Composition of Review Team - AoC

The reviews will be performed by volunteer community members ... and will include the following (or their designated nominees):

- GAC Chair
- ICANN CEO
- Relevant SO/ACs representatives
- Independent Experts

The RT Composition will be agreed jointly by the GAC Chair (in consultation with GAC members) and the ICANN CEO



#### **Objective**

Comply with Bylaws Examine organizational effectiveness



#### **Work Methods**

Examine documentation, records, reports; observe 360 Assessment – online survey Limited interviews

#### **Review Working Party**

Designated by Organization under review Serves as a liaison between the SIC, the organization under review, ICANN Stakeholders and Examiner



#### Criteria

Objective and quantifiable, consistently applied

3

#### **Independent Examiner**

Selected by competitive bid, based on set criteria Tightly scoped contract



#### **Continuous Improvement**

Apply lessons learned from prior reviews
Leverage best practices



### Organizational Review Cycle


#### Organizational Review Cycle – 5 Years



- ✓ Timeline has been extended to include multiple additional opportunities for the GNSO Review Working Party to continue the ongoing process of providing feedback to Westlake




### At-Large Review: Proposed Timeline
